

# Preparing Your Home for Interior Painting

To make sure your project runs efficiently and finishes beautifully, please review these quick steps before our team arrives:

## **1. Rearrange Your Space**

Shift furniture and larger pieces at least a few feet away from the walls so our crew can move freely and safely.

## **2. Take Down Wall Items**

Remove frames, shelves, or wall décor in the areas to be painted. Anything left hanging will be carefully worked around unless you tell us otherwise.

## **3. Window Area Prep**

Please take off any curtains or coverings within the workspace. Built-in blinds can stay if trim painting isn't part of your project.

## **4. Clear Off Surfaces**

Empty nearby counters, tables, or shelving to protect them from dust or splatter during prep and painting.

## **5. Minor Wall Fixes**

Our painters will repair small nail holes or surface marks unless nails or screws remain for items you plan to rehang; those can stay in place.

## **6. Disconnect & Move Electronics**

Unplug devices and move cords or small appliances a safe distance from the walls to keep everything clear and protected.

## **7. Organize Paint Choices**

If several paint colors are being used, label or stage each color in the room where you'd like it applied to avoid confusion.

## **8. Keep Pets Comfortable**

For everyone's safety, please secure pets in another area or floor until painting is complete.

## **For Ceiling Work:**

During ceiling projects, protective plastic coverings will be placed over furniture, floors, and walls. These will remain throughout the entire process for complete protection.
